For the last 20 years, Dr. Peter Marshall has worked in the field of adult, child and family psychology as a researcher, university professor, speaker and clinician in public and private practice.

In the course of his career, Marshall has served on the Board of Directors for the Elizabeth Fry Society and the Children's Aid Society. He taught psychology and psychiatry at Queen's University, and was a staff psychologist at Kingston General Hospital. He also served as a clinical consultant to the Kingston Prison for Women and the Frontenac County Board of Education.

With compassion, wit and wisdom, Marshall delivers a promising prognosis for some of society's most challenging issues.
